#### CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

We will be recommencing Children's Liturgy in June.



Children's Liturgy takes place every 1st, 3rd and 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the month at the 11am Mass. It is an opportunity for children to explore the gospel reading of the day in a

more child friendly way so that they understand it's message more clearly.

The sessions will be facilitated by adults who hold a current working with children and Police check, and the sessions take place in the Sacristy – at the front of the Church- so they are never too far from you, their parents. The children gather together at the beginning of Mass and re-join their parents after the Offertory procession. Children's liturgy is a great opportunity for your child to pray with children their own age so as to grow their relationship with God and Jesus. The first session will be Sunday the 5<sup>th</sup> of June.

#### **Online Lay Liturgical Ministry Training Courses**

Lay liturgical ministers can now access quality (in LITURGY online training and learn at their own pace, in their own homes, at times that suit them.

#### **WEEKEND READINGS**

First Reading: Acts 15:1-2. 22-29

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles

Some men came down from Judaea and taught the brothers, 'Unless you have yourselves circumcised in the tradition of Moses you cannot be saved.' This led to disagreement, and after Paul and Barnabas had a long argument with these men it was arranged that Paul and Barnabas and others of the church should go up to Jerusalem and discuss the problem with the apostles and elders.

Then the apostles and elders decided to choose delegates to send to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; the whole church concurred with this. They chose Judas known as Barsabbas and Silas, both leading men in the brotherhood, and gave them this letter to take with them:

'The apostles and elders, your brothers, send greetings to the brothers of pagan birth in Antioch, Syria and Cilicia. We hear that some of our members have disturbed you with their demands and have unsettled your minds. They acted without any authority from us, and so we have decided unanimously to elect delegates and to send them to you with Barnabas and Paul, men we highly respect who have dedicated their lives to the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. Accordingly we are sending you Judas and Silas, who will confirm by word of mouth what we have written in this letter. It has been decided by the Holy Spirit and by ourselves not to saddle you with any burden beyond these essentials: you are to abstain from food sacrificed to idols, from blood, from the meat of strangled animals and from fornication. Avoid these, and you will do what is right. Farewell.'

Second Reading: Revelation 21:10-14. 22-23

A reading from the Book of the Apocalypse

In the spirit, the angel took me to the top of an enormous high mountain and showed me Jerusalem, the holy city, coming down from God out of heaven. It had all the radiant glory of God and glittered like some precious jewel or crystal-clear diamond. The walls of it were of a great height, and had twelve gates; at each of the twelve gates there was an angel, and over the gates were written the names of the twelve tribes of Israel; on the east there were three gates, on the north three gates, on the south three gates, and on the west three gates. The city walls stood on twelve foundation stones, each one of which bore the name of one of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

I saw that there was no temple in the city since the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb were themselves the temple, and the city did not need the sun or the moon for light, since it was lit by the radiant glory of God and the Lamb was a lighted torch for it.

You heard me say: I am going away, and shall return. If you loved me you would have been glad to know that I am going to the Father, for the Father is greater than I. I have told you this now, before it happens, so that when it does happen you may believe.'

#### **EDUCATION IN FAITH**

"I make all things new!"

Today's first reading recounts for us the first great debate in the Church.

After listening to all the parties and praying, the apostles and elders respond: "It is the decision of the Holy Spirit and of us ..." The Apostles depended on the Holy Spirit they had received from Jesus. The Holy Spirit sent by the Father in Jesus' name will teach them everything and remind them of all that Jesus had told them. The Spirit did just that.

Through the centuries, the Church has followed the same path with new debates: listening, praying, and responding with the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

Along with the gift of the Holy Spirit, Jesus gives us the gift of his peace – a peace that is more profound than any peace the world might offer. Jesus' peace brings us the assurance that nothing can separate us from his love. Jesus' peace strengthens our faith and trust that we will be victorious over trials and suffering as Jesus was. Jesus' peace enables us to live with optimism and grace.

Jesus tells us: "Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid." If we choose to abide in Jesus' peace and seek opportunities to share that peace with one another, we will have no reason to be troubled or afraid.

Every breath we take is a reminder of the Holy Spirit within us and the gift of Jesus' peace in our hearts.

Let us breathe deeply today – and be at peace.
